

"The ATOS 350, a cracking little tractor"

Mr Hyde, Church Stretton, is predominantly a beef and sheep farmer. With around 60 Limousine cattle and calves and around 2,500 sheep at any one time, he is always on the go and needs a machine he can rely on.

"The visibility is good for a loader tractor, we use it for feeding the stock and the bale handling. I have never had any problems with visibility.

"The ATOS 350 will be working every day feeding the stock, it would still only do around 500-700 hours in a year. It is a good workhorse. We have only ever had one problem and as always with MORRIS CORFIELD you can guarantee if something is wrong, they won't stop until they put it right!

"On the ATOS 350 we have the standard mechanical transmission which works well for us. We like to have a good old gear stick, it's just simple and easy to use."
